

Marriages needed even more help than usual. So our team prayerfully dove right into hosting webinars, mentoring couples over Zoom, and running online conferences. And what a year it was!

- · This Day Forward Parenting Conference (in April) with over 1600 households represented.
- · Over 32,000 in attendance at FamilyLife Canada events (compared to 14,600 in 2019). That's more than double the marriages and families helped!"
