The Amtrak Auto-Train

Many have asked about our experience using the Auto-Train for our trip back East so here is a quick recap. The Auto Train is an 855-mile-long overnight train service for passengers and their cars operated between Lorton, Virginia (near Washington, D.C.), and Sanford, Florida (near Orlando). It started as an independent line sometime in the 1950's, and was taken over by Amtrak in 1983. The Auto Train is the only one of its kind in the United States! It may sound outdated but it runs EVERY DAY and still going strong. On our return trip, for example, there were 15 passenger cars carrying 238 coach and 239 sleeper passengers, attached to that were 32 car carriers with 251 vehicles (including 4 motorcycles). For us, traveling to both CT and PA, as well as bringing along boxes of FamilyLife resources, it turned out to be a great way to travel.
