Join me for a quick glimpse of FamilyLife working around the world! These stories encourage me as I write, and I am thrilled to share them with YOU!

We begin with FamilyLife **Philippines** recently holding an online event to celebrate 25 years of FamilyLife ministry in their country. They were encouraged by many stories and testimonies of God's faithfulness and power at work through the years. The evening also included a time of worship and a message from David Robbins. One of these testimonies shared that around 29 batches of *Vertical Marriage* online studies were conducted in 2021. So far our FL team there has trained small group facilitators and couples to run the whole event. It is amazing how the Lord is using this tool remarkably. To date, 41 *Vertical Marriage* studies have been conducted with 1000+ couples in attendance. We pray that more will be conducted this year."

Now off to **Canada**! *Together for Good* is a video-on-demand marriage workshop hosted by Neil and Sharol Josephson, the directors of FamilyLife Canada. This set of five sessions was developed specifically for use during COVID and gives couples tools, exercises and guided conversations to grow a healthier, more joy-filled and more resilient marriage. Neal says: "The last 20 months have been so difficult for so many people. But for FamilyLife Canada, the pandemic has turned out to be a great gift. For a long season, we were forced to move entirely online, and while we typically engage with about 5,000 people a year through our in-person conferences and seminars, during the pandemic we were able to engage digitally with over 40,000!" One couple impacted were Cathy and Joel Saladaga from Winnipeg who joined in for our *Together for Good* Free Streaming Weekend in November, 2020. They were person-

ally really encouraged and also caught the HomeBuilder vision. So they used *Together for Good* to host their own date night series over Zoom in the spring of 2021 and 38 couples participated. And they sure made it their own! They got couples making special date night dinners at home, doing symbolic hand painting, and even dancing in their living rooms, with the video feed still on!


